Art: Drawing and Painting In this unit, we are going to learn about tonking (a method of taking paint off/blotting a surface to reveal other marks), sgraffito (a method involving scratching through the surface layer of paint to reveal the layer beneath) and impasto (a painting technique in which the paint is applied so thickly that it stands out from the surface, creating texture). Once we have practised these in class, why not have a go at home and create your own masterpieces!	RE Can you create some artwork or comic strips to re-tell the story of Noah's Arc?
