Year Group	Homework
1	<p>Reading: Children should read to an adult for at least 10 minutes everyday. Books will be changed every Monday and Thursday. Each child has a coloured dot on their reading pack and a day written on it. On that day, the child will read with the teacher in a Guided Reading session so reading records should be in school.</p> <p>Spellings: Set every Friday, due in the following Friday. Spelling books should be in class every Friday.</p> <p>Maths Homework is set every other Friday: Set Friday 5th November and due Friday 12th November Set Friday 19th November and due Friday 26th November Set Friday 3rd December and due Friday 10th December</p>
2	<p>Daily reading – to be recorded in the Reading Records. Once a book has been read twice please record this and return the book to be changed.</p> <p>Spellings will be set weekly on a Friday ready for a test the following Friday. This will be displayed on the Class Page unless your child is given a separate list to learn.</p> <p>Maths Homework is set every other Friday: Set Friday 12th November and due Thursday 18th November Set Friday 26th November and due Thursday 2nd December Set Friday 10th November and due Thursday 16th December</p>
3	<p>Reading: Your child should be reading for 10 – 15 minutes every night to an adult. Please sign their reading record after you have heard them read. Discuss the text they have read, ask them questions about the characters and events.</p> <p>Spelling: The children will have a weekly spelling test and the words will be on the class website if you wish to practice with your child. Every other week, I will suggest a creative way for the children to learn their spellings - this will be set in the homework book and will be an optional activity.</p> <p>Maths Homework is set every other Monday: Set Monday 8th November and due Monday 15th November Set Monday 22nd November and due Monday 29th November Set Monday 6th December and due Monday 13th December</p>
4	<p>Reading: Children should be reading for 10-15 minutes each night, preferably with an adult. Please sign when you read with your child and also encourage them to make comments about the book they are reading on a regular basis. Reading books and diaries need to be in school each day.</p> <p>Spelling: Spelling will be set on a Monday to be tested the following Monday. The list will be</p>

	<p>displayed on the Class Page of the school website. There will also be an optional activity in the Homework Book.</p> <p>Maths Homework is set every other Monday: Set Monday 8th November and due Monday 15th November Set Monday 22nd November and due Monday 29th November Set Monday 6th December and due Monday 13th December</p>
5	<p>Reading: Your child should be reading for at least 10-15minutes each night. Please sign their reading record book at least once a week AND after they complete a book. Encourage your child to fill in their reading record book regularly.</p> <p>Spellings and Maths: will be set every Thursday for completion in their homework books. Homework is due in the following Thursday ready for marking and testing within class. There will not be work set on Google classroom but spelling lists will be on the class page of the school website.</p>
6	<p>Reading: Your child is expected to read to an adult at least four times a week and their diaries signed to reflect this. Tricky words should also be noted in the diary so they can independently research the meanings.</p> <p>Spellings and Mental Arithmetic will be set on a Wednesday every week for completion in their homework books. Homework is due in the following Wednesday ready for marking in class and testing. There will not be work set on Google classroom.</p>
